All applicants should aim to submit material as early as possible to ensure sufficient time for enrollment if admitted.

- Submit the Massasoit Application for Admission or the 2017-2018 Application for Selective Admissions Program.
- Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/Hi-SET completion, or other state approved equivalency credential.
- Submit all official transcripts from other institutions attended.
- Attend the required Paramedic Information Session, and submit the attendance confirmation form. Please call James Blandino, ext. 4003 to schedule a session. *(The time limit for attending an information session is one year).*
- Submit two letters of reference.
- Submit a personal letter of interest.
- Submit proof of EMT certification.
- Meet the Fundamentals of Math prerequisite*.
- Meet the Introduction to Writing and Preparation for College Reading II prerequisites*.

The Massasoit Community College Paramedic Program is accredited by the Massachusetts Department of Health, Office of Emergency Medical Services. The Program currently holds a Letter of Review from the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoEAMSP), which is NOT a CAAHEP accreditation status, but is a status granted by CoEAMSP signifying that a program seeking initial accreditation has demonstrated sufficient compliance with the accreditation Standards through the Letter of Review Self Study Report (LSSR) and other documentation. Letter of Review is recognized by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) for eligibility to take the NREMT's Paramedic credentialing examination(s). However, it is NOT a guarantee of eventual accreditation.

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
