**Students must graduate Massasoit with a cumulative 2.5 GPA to transfer to Bay State College.**

**Students must have a grade of C or higher in their Massasoit classes to transfer.**

It is recommended that students also take **Introduction to Sociology at Massasoit** prior to transferring.

#### Prerequisites

Some courses may have prerequisites. Please see course descriptions in the catalog or online course search for details.

**Bay State College recommends students receive the following grade of a B- or higher in the following courses:**

- **Financial Accounting I**
- **Principles of Economics I**
- **Principles of Economics II**
- **Introduction to Statistics**
- **Principles of Management**

By fulfilling these courses with a B- or higher, students who transfer to Bay State will also be eligible upon completion of their Bachelor's Degree to pursue a Master's Degree at New England College of Business and will already have completed 4 NECB equivalent MBA prerequisite courses!
