

## Checklist for applying to the Phlebotomy Certificate Program for Spring 2021

All items must be submitted together to the Brockton Admissions Office
 Attend the <u>mandatory</u> Information Session. Applicants must attend an Information Session prior to each application cycle.
 Submit the Massasoit Application for Admission or the 2020-2021 Application for Selective Admissions Program.
 Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
 Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
 Complete Accuplacer Placement Testing.
 Meet the reading, writing, and math prerequisites*.

All applicants will be scored using the enclosed rubric.

\*Applicants must have completed developmental English courses (ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) and Fundamentals of Math (Math 010) or received an equivalent Accuplacer Score.
