

Health Services Information

For medical emergencies:

- **Day/Evening** - call Campus Police on classroom room phone, press third top grey button **EMERGENCY** or dial x911 or use **yellow Emergency Call Boxes
- Health Services are available on a limited basis on our campuses. There is not a health office on the Brockton campus. In the case of an emergency medical situation, call 911. You may also contact College Police at 911 from a campus landline phone or (508) 427-1296.
- On the Canton campus, the Health Office is located in room C136. The college nurse is available part-time during the academic year, from 9:00am - 2:00pm, (508) 588-9100 x2451.
- In Middleborough, call 911 in the case of an emergency.

Requirements:

All full-time students and all students on a VISA must provide proof of immunization for:

- Tetanus – Diphtheria (Td/Tdap) – last dose within 5 years.
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella - Series of 2 Measles, given at least one month apart after 1st birthday.
- Hepatitis B - Series of 3
- Varicella, 2 doses, one month apart after 1st birthday.

Note: Serological proof may be provided for MMR, Hep B., and Varicella.
High School and military immunization information may be submitted.
A medical exemption must be signed by a doctor. There is no age exemption.
