Massasoit Community College offers an Associate’s Degree in Social Science Transfer. EMSI job definitions below.

- **Social Science Research Assistants (SOC 19-4061):** Assist social scientists in laboratory, survey, and other social science research. May help prepare findings for publication and assist in laboratory analysis, quality control, or data management. Excludes 'Graduate Teaching Assistants' (25-1191).
- **Social Scientists and Related Workers, All Other (SOC 19-3099):** All social scientists and related workers not listed separately.
- **Social and Community Service Managers (SOC 11-9151):** Plan, direct, or coordinate the activities of a social service program or community outreach organization. Oversee the program or organization's budget and policies regarding participant involvement, program requirements, and benefits. Work may involve directing social workers, counselors, or probation officers.
- **Social and Human Service Assistants (SOC 21-1093):** Assist in providing client services in a wide variety of fields, such as psychology, rehabilitation, or social work, including support for families. May assist clients in identifying and obtaining available benefits and social and community services. May assist social workers with developing, organizing, and conducting programs to prevent and resolve problems relevant to substance abuse, human relationships, rehabilitation, or dependent care. Excludes 'Rehabilitation Counselors' (21-1015), 'Psychiatric Technicians' (29-2053), 'Personal Care Aides' (39-9021), and 'Eligibility Interviewers, Government Programs' (43-4061).
- **Sociologists (SOC 19-3041):** Study human society and social behavior by examining the groups and social institutions that people form, as well as various social, religious, political, and business organizations. May study the behavior and interaction of groups, trace their origin and growth, and analyze the influence of group activities on individual members.
- **Healthcare Social Workers (SOC 21-1022):** Provide individuals, families, and groups with the psychosocial support needed to cope with chronic, acute, or terminal illnesses. Services include advising family caregivers. Provide patients with information and counseling, and make referrals for other services. May also provide case and care management or interventions designed to promote health, prevent disease, and address barriers to access to healthcare.
