

Checklist for applying to the Paramedic Certificate Program for Fall 2024.

 New students to Massasoit may apply online or submit a paper application. Massasoit students currently enrolled in a degree program, should submit the application for selective admissions.
 Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/Hi-SET completion, or other state approved equivalency credential. All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
Submit all official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
Attend the required Information Session. (The time limit for attending an Information Session is one year)
 Submit proof of EMT certification.
 Meet the prerequisites in reading, writing, and mathematics. Students may meet this requirement by taking the college placement exams and testing out of or completing any developmental courses (Fundamentals of Math, Introduction to Writing, and College Reading II) prior to the start of the program, or by transferring college level courses.

*The priority deadline date is August 1 for Fall. Applications received after the priority deadline will be reviewed on a space available basis. (This program is not financial aid eligible.)
