| <br>Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.                   |
| <br>Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.   |
| <br>Complete Accuplacer Placement Testing.  |
| <br>Meet the reading, writing, and math prerequisites*.   |

\*Applicants must have completed developmental English courses (ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) and Fundamentals of Math (Math 010) or received an equivalent Accuplacer Score.
