

## Checklist for applying to the Phlebotomy Certificate Program for Fall 2022

Please use the following checklist to help organize your application materials.

- \_\_\_\_\_ New students to Massasoit may apply online or submit a paper application. Massasoit students currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program, should submit the application for Selective Admissions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Attend the **required** Information Session.  
(The time limit for attending an Info Session is one year)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete Accuplacer Placement Testing.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet the reading, writing, and math prerequisites\*.

All applicants will be scored using the enclosed rubric.

\*Applicants must have completed developmental English courses (ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) and Fundamentals of Math (Math 010) or received an equivalent Accuplacer Score.
