



Checklist for applying to the Dental Assistant Program for Fall 2024

Please use the following check sheet to help organize your application materials.

- _____ New students to Massasoit should submit a paper application. Massasoit students enrolled in a degree program, should submit the application for selective admissions.
- _____ Attend the required Information Session.
(The time limit for attending an Info Session is one year).
- _____ Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
- _____ Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
- _____ Complete Accuplacer Placement Testing.
- _____ Meet the reading, writing, and math prerequisites*.

All applicants will be scored using the enclosed rubric.

*Applicants must have completed developmental English courses (ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) and Fundamentals of Math (Math 010) or received an equivalent Accuplacer Score.

The priority deadline date for submitting completed application materials to the Admissions Office is April 30, 2024.
