

Checklist for applying to the Full-time LPN to Associate Degree Advanced Placement Nurse Education for Fall 2024

Please use the following check sheet to help organize your application materials.

All items must be submitted to the Admissions Office before the deadline date of April 1, 2024

- _____ New students to Massasoit should submit a paper application. Massasoit students currently enrolled in a degree program, should submit the application for selective admissions.
- _____ Submit documentation of high school graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
- _____ Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended (including LPN school). International college or university transcripts must be evaluated by a certified evaluation company and submitted along with a copy of the original college or university transcript.
- _____ Attend the required Information Session (The time limit for attending an Information Session is one year). Please register online at massasoit.edu/information-sessions
- _____ Meet the Anatomy and Physiology I & II and General Psychology minimum prerequisites.
- _____ Applicants must hold current licensure as an LPN in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and submit a copy of licensure verification.
- _____ Submit ATI TEAS test results. All TEAS tests must be the current version and must be taken in-person.

All applicants will be scored using a rubric.
