

Checklist for applying to the Veterinary Technology Program for Fall 2024 Please use the following check sheet to help organize your application materials.
— New students to Massasoit should submit a paper application. Massasoit students enrolled in a degree program, should submit the application for selective admissions.
Attend the required Information Session. (The time limit for attending an Info Session is one year).
Submit documentation of High School graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.
Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.
Submit two letters of reference.
Submit one letter of interest.
Sign and submit acknowledgment of Technical Standards for Veterinary Technology Program Students.
Meet the Math*, English*, Biology**, and Chemistry*** prerequisites.
All applicants will be scored using a rubric.
*Applicants must have completed Intermediate Algebra (MATH112) and Developmental English courses
(ENGL 091, ENGL 092 & ENGL 099) or received an equivalent Accuplacer score.
**Applicants must have completed Biological Principles or an equivalent course or submit an appropriate score on the Challenge exam.
***Applicants must have completed General Chemistry or an equivalent course.
THE DEADLINE DATE FOR SUBMITTING COMPLETED APPLICATION MATERIALS TO THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE IS MAY 28, 2024.
