

Checklist for applying to the Veterinary Technology Program for Fall 2023

Please use the following check sheet to help organize your application materials.

 New students to Massasoit may apply online or submit a paper application. Massasoit students currently enrolled in a degree or certificate program, should submit the application for Selective Admissions.

 Attend the required Information Session.

 (The time limit for attending an Info Session is one year).

 Submit documentation of High School graduation, GED/HiSET, or other state approved equivalency credential (transcript or diploma). All foreign high school transcripts must be evaluated.

 Submit official college transcripts from other institutions attended.

 Submit two letters of reference.

 Submit a personal essay.

 Sign and submit acknowledgment of Technical Standards for Veterinary Technology Program Students.

 Meet the College Level Math*, English*, Biology**, and Chemistry*** prerequisites.

All applicants will be scored using a rubric.

*Applicants must have completed Intermediate Algebra (MATH112) and Developmental English courses (ENGL091 & ENGL099) or received an equivalent Accuplacer score.

**Applicants must have completed Biological Principles or an equivalent course or submit an appropriate score on the Challenge exam.

***Applicants must have completed General Chemistry or an equivalent course.

THE DEADLINE DATE FOR SUBMITTING COMPLETED APPLICATION MATERIALS TO THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE IS July 5, 2023.
