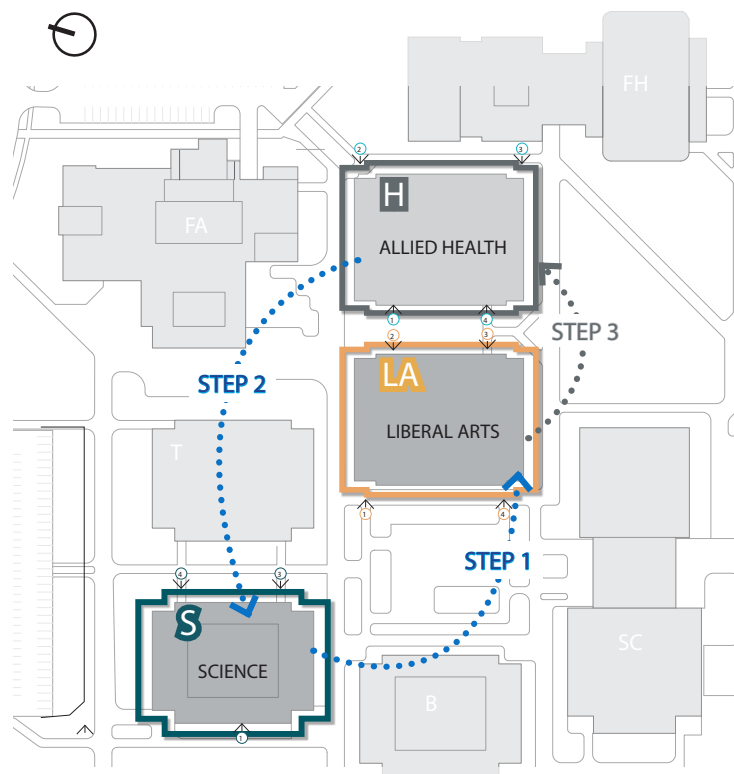
Who Are We?

We are the design team embarking on a [Transformation through Renovation](#) at Massasoit Community College to update both the Liberal Arts and Science Buildings into modern teaching spaces.



What is the Project?

Science labs will be built out within the Liberal Arts Building, and Allied Health (Nursing & Respiratory) will move into a newly renovated, purpose-built space within the vacated Science Building.

- H** HUMANITIES BUILDING

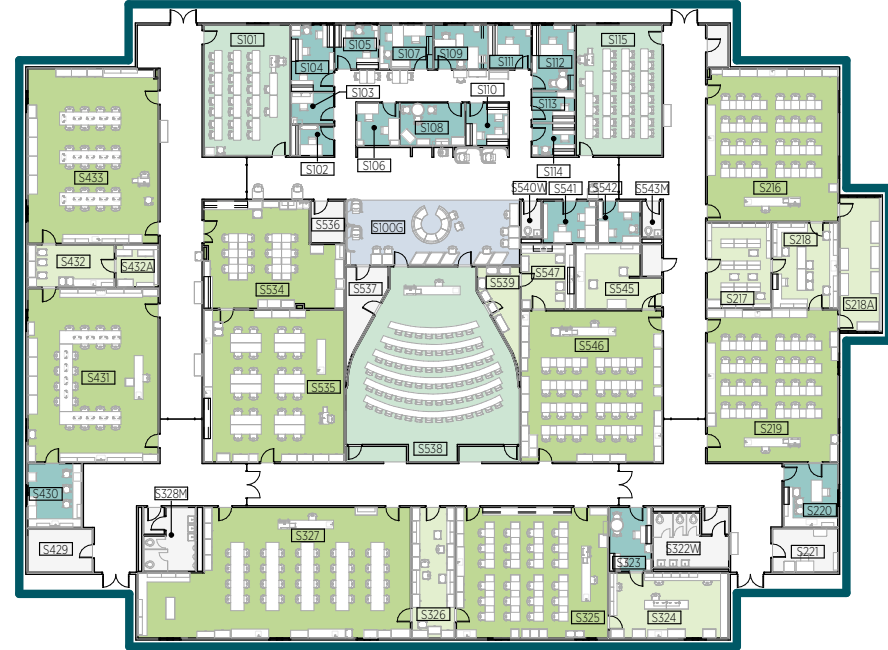
PROJECT SEQUENCE

- STEP 1** RENOVATE THE LA BUILDING TO SCIENCE
- STEP 2** RENOVATE THE S BUILDING TO NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH
- STEP 3** BACKFILL VACATED ALLIED HEALTH SPACE IN THE H BUILDING WITH LIBERAL ARTS

WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

SCIENCE AND MATH PROGRAM - EXISTING SCIENCE BUILDING

Step 1: The **Science** program will relocate to the Liberal Arts Building.



The new space will house science labs, lab support spaces, green house, and teaching spaces.

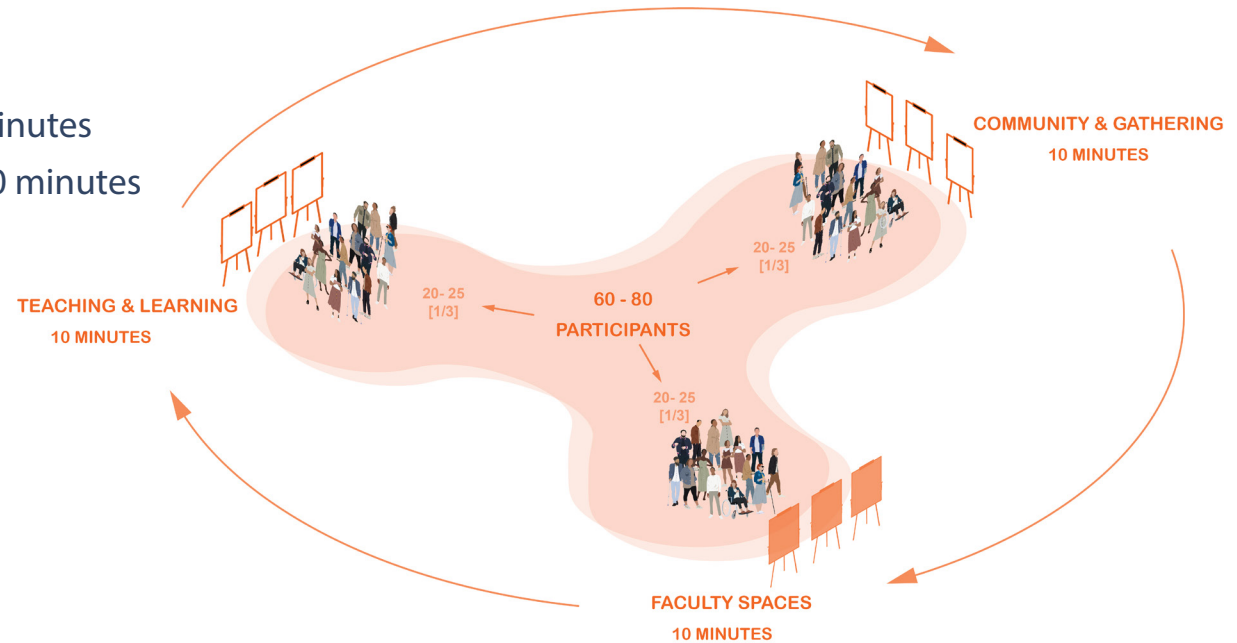
What Are we Asking?



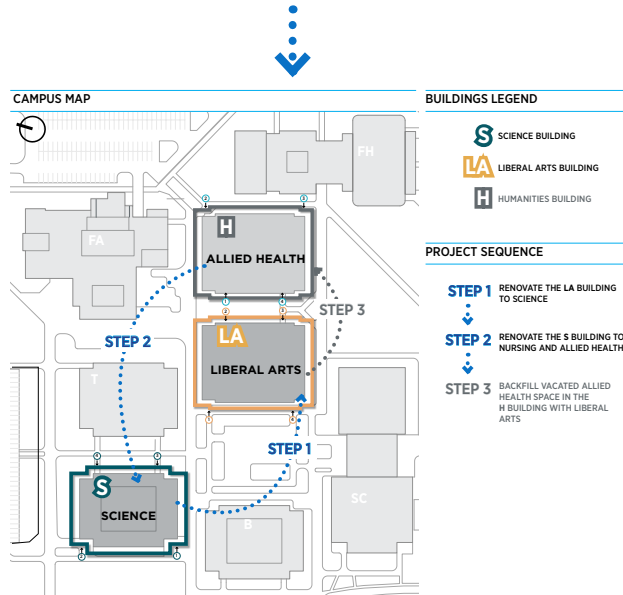
