

- 3. Integrate artwork and branding opportunities in public spaces.















2. What types of seating in an OPEN GATHERING space are more useful to you?














- 3. Locate vending machines near individual study areas, and prioritize white boards for group study areas.












- 4. Allow for access to natural light.





- 3. Spell out building names on the exterior and incorporate large text.












