Commencement Day Information

- Commencement day check-in is in the Field House gym at 9:30
 am. Please wear comfortable shoes, as you will be standing while waiting to process.
- You will be given a card with your name on it, and your name will be announced on stage as it appears on the card.
- Cords of recognition (gold for highest honors 3.90 or higher*; red, white & blue for veterans) will be provided at check-in at the Field House on the morning of commencement.
- All diplomas will be mailed to graduates 6-8 weeks from the Commencement.
- Faculty marshals will lead the procession lines and direct you to your seat. Please follow the person ahead of you.
- You will be asked to proceed row by row to the stage, where you will hand your card to the reader.
- At the end of the ceremony, faculty, staff, trustees, and the platform party will form a recessional on the walkway to congratulate graduates, weather permitting.
- For those unable to be on campus, the ceremony will be streamed live. A link to the live stream will be on the College home page, massasoit.edu, on the day of Commencement.
