About the Test


On the ATI TEAS test you will have 209 minutes (3 ½ hours) to answer a total of 170 questions. The sections are broken down as follows:

SECTION	#OF QUESTIONS	TIME – in mins.	Specific Content Covered
READING	45	55	Key ideas, craft and structure, integration of knowledge and ideas
MATHEMATICS	38	57	Numbers and Algebra, measurement and data
SCIENCE	50	60	Human Anatomy & Physiology, Biology, Chemistry, Scientific reasoning
ENGLISH & LANGUAGE USE	37	37	Conventions of standard English, Knowledge of language, using language and vocabulary to express ideas in writing


